

Mental Health and Behavioral Support Pathway

Data Driven Identification of At-Risk Student Teacher/School Staff Identification of At-Risk Student Parent/Family/Self Identification of At-Risk Student

Choice of Pathway (May include both)

Mental Health Service

PBIS Intervention

FRYSC staff provide information to care-givers about school-based and/or community-based mental health options

School staff initiate a PBIS intervention matched to student need

Student progress is reviewed at least monthly through the school PBIS Team

If data suggests adequate improvement gains have been made and maintained, begin phasing out intervention and continue with Tier 1 supports

If data suggests adequate improvement but inadequate maintenance, continue with intervention and data monitoring If data suggests inadequate improvement, ensure fidelity of implementation and/or consider the need to alter or add an intervention

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
